After the Burj Khalifa: Klüh also receives FM order for the 307 metre-high “Cayan Tower” in Dubai

Düsseldorf, 19. January 2017. At 829 metres, the Burj Khalifa is the highest building in the world. Since 2010, Berkeley Services UAE, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Klüh Service Management GmbH, has been responsible for the cleaning. Now, Berkeley Services has also received the order for the extensive facility management of another prestigious building in Dubai: the Cayan Tower. With a height of 307 metres, 75 floors and 500 apartments, this building is the second architectural icon in the Gulf.

The tower, designed by the same group of architects as the Burj Khalifa, was inaugurated in June 2013. It is the tallest building in the world with a 90-degree twist in its structure.

Berkeley Services beat five competitors to win the tenders, and was awarded the contract for the complete facility management of the property. Alongside cleaning and security, this also includes services such as the landscape design, the laundry service, the disposal management and the pest control.
