“We for Düsseldorf” enters new round of applications

Josef Klüh to continue to support Düsseldorf’s charitable organizations

Düsseldorf, 7 November 2017 – “We for Düsseldorf”, the private initiative of Josef Klüh, is entering a new round of applications. The Düsseldorf entrepreneur will make a further 25,000 euros available for various social projects. Charitable organizations from Düsseldorf can apply for grants as of now.

According to the figures of the State Statistical Office, child poverty is a widespread problem in North Rhine-Westphalia. Almost one in four young people under the age of 18 was at risk of poverty in 2016. “Helping the disadvantaged and underprivileged in our society is a matter very close to my heart. I believe that it is important to support those organizations, particularly here in my home city of Düsseldorf, which are standing up for and are committed to helping people in this great city”, said Josef Klüh. The donation campaign favors projects which focus on and promote the well-being of children, the elderly and other people in need.

A jury comprising Dr. Vera Geisel, the wife of Lord Mayor Thomas Geisel, Jonges-Baas Wolfgang Rolshoven and entrepreneur Josef Klüh makes the final decision on which organizations shall receive a financial donation. The awarded amount will be transferred over to the selected projects in the spring of 2018.
