Top performance at the Burj Khalifa since 2010

Klüh designated "Cleaning Company of the Year" in Dubai

Düsseldorf / Dubai, 19 June 2018 – Since 2010, the Klüh company Berkeley Services has been responsible for cleaning the Burj Khalifa, the world's tallest building at 829 metres.
